iPhone users can install it by searching for our school name "Hampstead Primary School" in the Apple App Store.



We have been fortunate to have guest speakers visit us and even an excursion into the city of Adelaide to further our learning about National Sorry Day. Our visitors included the Red Cross, who visited us and spoke about their Migration Support Program for immigrants and Constable Andrew from SAPOL, who spoke about cyber usage and cyber bullying.

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National Sorry Day Excursion

Room 7 joined Room 5 on an excursion to learn about National Sorry Day. We all headed into the city via public bus, which all the students enjoyed very much. We arrived at the event which was held at Victoria Square, where many agencies took part in providing support and knowledge to remember the mistreatment of Australia's indigenous population who were part of the Stolen Generation.





Police Presentation: Cyber Bullying and Cyber Usage

Our class were privileged to have a police officer visit our school and discuss with us the importance of knowing more about the cyber world. Constable Andrew taught students about managing privacy settings, the use of social media and the importance of knowing who is online. The students enjoyed discussing this topic and learning more about the cyber world they live in.

Fransesca from Red Cross provided information about the reasons as to why people leave their country and the challenges they are faced with. The students were very interested in understanding more about why and what happens when people flee their country showing an engaged curiosity.
