Each year all students in SA undertake learning assessments in the following areas:

- NAPLaN –Literacy and Numeracy
- PAT R – Reading Comprehension
- PAT M – mathematics
- Reading Level Assessment

This year our students achieved outstanding results in reading.

Reading Level Assessment	Year 1 75% achieved at or above the State Standard of Educational Achievement (SEA)	Year 2 70% achieved at or above the State Standard of Educational Achievement (SEA)
NAPLaN Reading	Year 5 75% of students achieving SEA Achieved in the high bands (well above their year level)	Year 7 83% of students achieved at or above the State Standard of Educational Achievement (SEA)

Sports Day

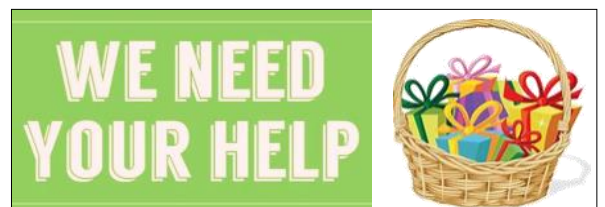
