#### MATHS

##### Whole school focus: Number

Students will reflect on their term 1 goals within number and reset for term 2 accordingly. Daily practice in developing fluency and effective strategies in number facts, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division will continue to be a focus of our learning in mathematics.

##### Measurement

Students will explore concepts and develop skills in measurement through ordering and compare objects using familiar metric units of length, mass and capacity.

**Writing:** Genre focus: Procedural texts

- Purpose, structure and language features of procedural texts
