MATHS

To spark students curiosity in mathematics we will explore how, when & why we use maths in the world whilst developing their understanding of how they perceive themselves as mathematicians.

Bushfire Enterprise

Students will be using mathematics to plan for, create and analyse their own cup cake stall with all profits raised going towards the bushfire recovery. Students will be learning and implementing skills and knowledge in:

- Money & financial mathematics
- Measurement
- Collecting, representing & analysing data

ENGLISH

Writing & Speaking: Persuasive writing & Recount

Students will be planning and creating written and oral/digital advertisements to advertise their cup cake stall and pyjama day. All money raised will go towards bushfire recovery.

Language features, structure and vocabulary will be a focus when creating their advertisements and recounts.



Reading Comprehension

Students will be working towards specific reading goals in daily guided reading sessions to improve their comprehension to become *balanced readers* and increase their joy for reading.

NAPLAN preparation will take place term. Students will practice reading a range of texts on screen and implementing appropriate strategies to answer questions correctly.

SCIENCE with Mr M
