

MATHS


Students will develop their skills and understanding of number in the following ways



- Daily worded problem solving involving the 4 operations.
- Interpreting and using money in 'real world' situations such as working out correct change and do I have enough?
- Modelling and representing fractions
- Individualised maths goals based on multiplication facts focussing on fluency and recall.

ENGLISH

C.P.C/HEALTH & PE

This term student will be exploring the values of kindness, co-operation and respect as well as learning about the importance of keeping safe through recognising and reporting abuse in regards to the following topics

- 1. Privacy and the body
- 2. Recognising abuse
- 3. Cyber safety

SCIENCE

Students will have the opportunity to investigate the behaviour of how substances react when heated and cooled. They will explore how liquids and solids respond to changes in temperature.



HASS

Students will be exploring the importance of culture and place to the Ngarrindjerri people and their sustainable ways of living around the River Murray. Students will research how the river environment has changed overtime since European settlement and the impact on the geographical features as well as the native flora and fauna.

ARTS

This term the main focus in Media Arts for children from Reception to Year 7 is —Things Aren't What They Seem. Children will be using Green Screen Technology and various iPad Apps to produce Optical Illusions and Abstract Art. A key focus will be on target audience and use of colour. Each student will be encouraged to produce a self portrait (Abstract Art— Pop Art). Children will be encouraged to provide each other with warm and uplifting comments. Each child will contribute to a movie with their self portrait but also including one thing they are proud of about themselves and one wish/dream.
