### Literacy

### Numeracy

#### **Number**

Focus on learning strategies **to estimate, measure and compare length, temperature, volume, capacity and mass** to solve everyday problems.

Students to **recognise and describe simple prisms and pyramids** and make models of 3D objects.

Students to calculate percentage discounts on sale items.

Students will solve problems involving Length and Area.

Students will solve word problems involving time duration.

Students will be exposed to a number of problem-solving strategies that they will then need to apply to real world problems.
